Important Information In Preparation For Performance

# Arrival Time

Normally (with no special requests from the client), we arrive to load in 1.5 - 2 hours before the performance start time.

## Performance Area / Stage

The performance area must be reasonably flat and dry (to guard against electrical hazards). **The performance area must be no less than:** 

Band: 9' x 12' Duo: 7' x 8'

### **Electrical Power**

We require just one electrical outlet (wall, extension cord, etc.). The outlet must be no more than 100 feet from the performance area. (We appreciate the outlet being as close as to performance area possible.)

**The electrical outlet must be of normal/standard specifications** (120 volts, 15-20 amps, 60Hz non-distorted sine wave). If electricity will be sourced from a fuel-powered generator, we strongly recommend verifying that the electrical output is of standard specifications well before the event; substandard power could be catastrophic to our electronic equipment. The client will be responsible for the quality of electricity provided. *We recommend providing electricity from the power utility whenever possible*.

It is recommended we have our own circuit. In other words, it is best if we don't share a circuit with other electrical devices such as electrical motors, light dimmers, heaters, etc. (Such devices might create undesirable noise in sound system and/or cause a breaker to trip, interrupting the performance.)

*We can supply electricity to off-grid locations*: With our reliable, clean lithium-ion power supplies (no gasoline, no fumes, no noise, no permit required), we can provide an off-grid performance up to a four-hours for the band, up to six-hours for the duo. There is an additional charge for this service.

# **Shade**

If it is an outdoor daytime performance, we and our equipment must be shaded from load in to load out. There are three options:

1) Choose a shaded location for our set up if there is an appropriate shaded area.

2) We have our own shade "pop-up" with an 11'x11' base (footprint). If our pop-up can fit within the performance area, we will use it.

3) If client is providing a raised stage (daytime, outdoors), it must be no less than 12'x12' for a band, no less than 7'x8' for a duo. If the stage provided can't accommodate our pop-up, we require client to provide shade covering.



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
